Greenhouse Rules
ONE space per household. Please contact a member of the Garden and Greenhouse Committee if you need an extra space.
No fuchsias. The experts advise that the fuchsia is particularly susceptible to the whitefly and can easily bring contamination to other plants.
Ensure that geraniums do NOT have bud worm before bringing them to the greenhouse.

Plants must be healthy. They must be insect, disease, and fungus free. Mature plants should be pruned and sprayed before placing in the greenhouse. Plants are placed in the greenhouse at owner's risk. Diseased or dead plants may be removed at the discretion of the Garden and Greenhouse Committee.

Do NOT use chemicals in the greenhouse. If your plant needs a chemical treatment, take it home or outside the greenhouse for the treatment. Then you can bring it back in.

One whitefly strip is required for each space to be placed near your plants. Please replace periodically as suggested on package.

Responsibility for watering, fertilizing, and caring for plants lies with the owner. **Periodic visits to the greenhouse for this purpose are expected.** An 'Alternate Contact' is required for owners who anticipate being away during part of the season.

Care only for your own plants. If you notice a plant needing water, contact the Garden and Greenhouse Committee or the owner of the plant. Over watering can kill.

Keep all three levels (hanging, shelf + ground) of your space clear of weeds, trimmings, and trash. Please use the covered trashcan outside to dispose of debris.

Large or heavy pots should be on the ground level. Shade plants should also be placed on the ground level. **Be sure to allow breathing room for your plants.** You may also use the hanging area above the main shelf of your space.

No food or beverage is allowed inside the greenhouse. This draws bugs.
